The Shrine of Christ's Passion
October 23, 2014 ~ Pilgrimage



Let's enter our Centennial year by taking a walk with Jesus. We will devote some time for spiritual renewal and beauty. The Shrine of Christ's Passion in St. John, IN, allows pilgrims to be with Jesus Christ as He walked through His last days on earth. Fifteen acres feature 40 life-size bronze sculptures on the half mile winding pathway; which depicts the Holy Land by its stones, grass and trees. The Stations of the Cross are set into private alcoves, so the next station is not visible. Also included are two Marian shrines, a shrine to the sanctity of human life, and a well-stocked religious gift shop that ranks #1 in the region. Two beautiful places of inspiration—The Shrine of Christ's Passion and St. John the Evangelist Church are included on this pilgrimage.

- Meet at St. Margaret Mary at 7:45 a.m.
- Travel via motor coach. Prayer, reflection, fellowship time.
- First stop: St. John the Evangelist Parish for Holy Mass with Fr. Peter Sarnicki. Tour included.
- Next, a warm and delicious lunch at Teibel's Family Restaurant.
- Pilgrims arrive at The Shrine of Christ's Passion. (Handicap accessible). Group picture and then outdoor Way of the Cross. The path takes about an hour and a half.
- Gift Shop for shopping and exploring on our own. Depart for home at 3:30 p.m.

Time: 7:45 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

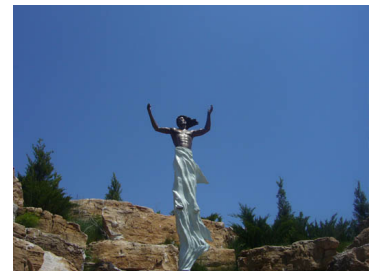
Cost: \$70.00 includes all tours, taxes, tips, meal and transportation.
